

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PART OF A PUBLIC STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD AS SHOWN ON THE RECORDED PLAT OF OAKWOOD FIRST ADDITION.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood has agreed to the vacation of the west part of Post Oak Lane as requested by petitioners,

and,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood, Missouri, as follows:

Section 1. Vacation of part of a public street.

That, in compliance to petition of adjacent owners, the western 218 feet and 50 feet of Post Oak Lane shall be vacated.

Section 2. That said petition, having been presented to the Clay County Court and requested vacation being granted by said Court, the above described portion of Post Oak Lane shall be declared vacated.

Section 3. The vacation of said part of Post Oak Lane is recorded in Book 1526, page 697 of the Clay County Records of Deeds. (November 28, 1903).
