

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SEWER LINE AND UPON COMPLETION, ACCORDING TO SPECIFICATIONS, TO BE ACCEPTED AND MAINTAINED BY THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. There has heretofore been conveyed to the Village of Oakwood, an easement for sewer purposes described as follows:

All of the North five (5) feet of Lot Ten (10);
and all of the South five (5) feet of Lot Eleven (11); all in REINHARDT ADDITION, a subdivision of land in the Village of Oakwood, Clay County, Missouri.

Section 2. The Village does now authorize the construction of a sewer line on said easement in accordance with the plans and specifications submitted to the Village by Larkin & Associates, identified as "Brooks Sewers" and identified by Larkin & Associates as Job #71072 dated 8/12/71, to be paid for by Darwin and Marjorie Brooks and with no liability on the Village.

Now then, it is resolved by the Village that upon completion of said sewer line in accordance with said specifications and upon full payment thereof by Darwin and Marjorie Brooks the sewer line will be accepted by the Village and maintained by the Village with permission granted to Darwin and Marjorie Brooks to connect thereto.

Section 3. Be it further ordained and resolved by the Village that a certification by letter from Larkin & Associates that this sewer line has been installed pursuant to the specifications, will constitute the Village's acceptance of said sewer line.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Board of Trustees and approval by the Chairman of the Board of Trustees.
