

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A STOP SIGN AT THE INTERSECTION OF POPLAR DRIVE AND SOUTH WOODLAND DRIVE IN THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD, CLAY COUNTY, MISSOURI

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD, CLAY COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In the interest of the welfare of the residents of said Village a stop sign for southbound traffic on Poplar Drive is hereby established at the intersection of Poplar Drive and South Woodland Drive.

Section 2. Said Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect from and after passage of this ordinance according to law.
