

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ADOPTION OF SPECIFICATIONS FOR EROSION AND SEDIMENT CONTROL IN THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD.

Whereas the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood, Clay County, Missouri, deems it necessary to control erosion and sedimentation on construction sites within said Village,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. Specifications for erosion and sediment control are hereby adopted to provide for methods of eliminating soil erosion and sedimentation on construction sites in the Village of Oakwood.
- Section 2. The requirements set forth in these specifications shall apply to any project that disturbs one or more acres of total land area.
- Section 3. It shall be the responsibility of the primary contractor to establish and maintain erosion and sedimentation controls on the construction site.
- Section 4. Failure to implement controls or failure of the controls to function properly shall result in work stoppage of all construction activities.
- Section 5. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from the date of passage.
