

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING USE OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD TO GOOGLE FIBER MISSOURI, LLC pursuant to 67.2679.7,RSMO2000, FEE AMOUNT OF GROSS RECEIPTS PAID TO OAKWOOD 5%.


WHEREAS, Google Fiber Missouri, LLC desires to install a small trial run of a newer faster micro-trenching deployment technique in the edge of the roadway and within the right-of-way of the Village of Oakwood; and in the event that the trial is a success intends to extend deployment further into the Village of Oakwood; and

WHEREAS, the Trustees of the Village of Oakwood have determined that this will not affect the general health and welfare of the residents of the Village of Oakwood or the Village itself.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD, CLAY COUNTY, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1. That the Board of Trustees of the Village of Oakwood, Clay County, Missouri, hereby authorizes Google Fiber to use the right-of-way within the Village for the purpose of installing, servicing, or removing its fiber optic cables using the micro-trenching deployment technique as described in Exhibit A. Google Fiber will consult with the Village regarding any variations to the specifications.
- Section 2. That Google Fiber shall indemnify, defend, and hold the Village of Oakwood harmless from and against any and all liability on account of injury to persons or damage to property caused by the negligence of Google Fiber in the exercise of its work.
- Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of that said agreement is executed on behalf of the Village of Oakwood, Missouri.

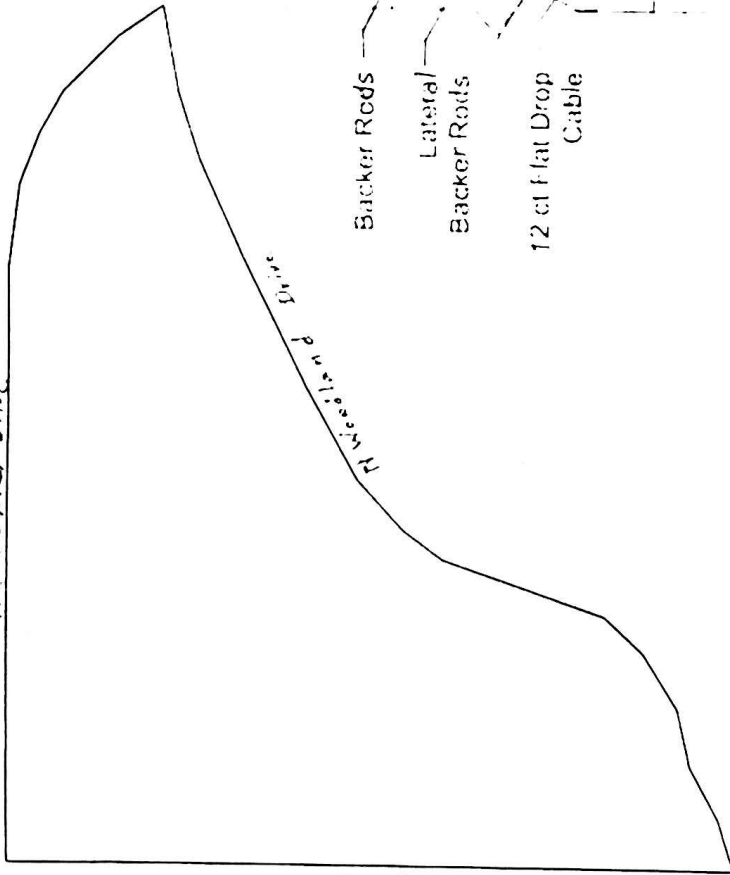
