

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING CERTAIN STANDARD RIGHT-OF-WAY AND EASEMENT CONVEYANCES OF PROPERTY WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD, CLAY COUNTY, MISSOURI, IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENT OF NORTH OAK STREET TRAFFICWAY.

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees has determined that it is necessary and reasonable for the Village of Oakwood to acquire certain rights-of-way and easements in connection with the construction and improvement of North Oak Street Trafficway, and

WHEREAS, on December 6, 1973, the Village of Oakwood and the City of Gladstone entered into a cooperative agreement for the construction and improvement of North Oak Street Trafficway, and

WHEREAS, the agreement of December 6, 1973, between the Village of Oakwood and the City of Gladstone provides that any interests in real estate acquired in connection with the construction and improvement of North Oak Street Trafficway which lie within the Village of Oakwood shall be conveyed to the Village of Oakwood and that all costs in connection with such acquisition shall be borne by the City of Gladstone.

BE IT THEREFORE ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OAKWOOD, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: That the following described Standard Right-of-Way and Easement Conveyances have been executed by the identified property owners, conveying to the Village of Oakwood the interests in land as described in the various conveyances, for the consideration set forth therein, which said conveyances are attached hereto and identified as Exhibits A through D, inclusive, each of which said conveyances is hereby accepted:

SECTION 3: After the City of Gladstone has made the payments to the grantors as provided in Section 2 hereof, the City Clerk of the City of Gladstone is hereby authorized to record said Standard Right-of-Way and Easement Conveyances, together with a certified copy of this ordinance, in the office of the Recorder of Deeds, Liberty, Clay County, Missouri.
